THE CITY OF CHENEY, KANSAS

ORDINANCE NO. 909

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF CURFEW PROVISIONS OF THE CHENEY CITY CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 11-209 OF THE CHENEY CITY CODE AND REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CHENEY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHENEY, KANSAS:

Section 1. AMENDING SECTION 11-209 OF THE CHENEY CITY CODE.

Section 11-209 of the Cheney City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“11-209 SAME; PENALTY. Any minor violating the provisions of Sections 11-207 through 11-208 of this Code shall be dealt in accordance with the juvenile code of the State of Kansas. Any officer finding a minor under the age of 18 years violating the provisions of Sections 11-207 through 11-208 shall warn the child to desist from such violation and immediately return home, and shall promptly report the violation to the juvenile court. Such officer shall then cause a written notice to be served upon the parent, guardian or person in charge of such minor, setting forth the manner in which the provisions of this Article have been violated. Any parent, guardian or person in charge of such a minor receiving written notice of such violation shall be issued a written warning or fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00 for such offense.”

Section 2. Repeal

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. However, any section of an existing ordinance not in conflict herewith is not repealed and remains in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the official city newspaper.
