HONORABLE MAYOR MIZE AND MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

MEMBERS PRESENT

Mayor Philip Mize, Council members Jeff Albers, Kassie Gile, Greg Williams, Greg Kampling and Ryan Graf. Staff present were City Administrator Danielle Young, Maintenance Superintendent Brad Ewy, Police Chief Ken Winter and Director of Golf Kevin Fowler.

Mayor Mize called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

COVID-19 POLICY

City Administrator Young stated they were not there to discuss “if” COVID-19 was going to happen, but they were there to prepare the City for “when” COVID-19 does affect the City. If it doesn’t affect us, then we can say we did everything we could to prevent it. Young stated they needed to address our employee situation and then our City. It is important to remember that we must limit exposure to our employees because without them, providing public safety and utilities are in jeopardy.

A policy was presented addressing areas such as employee travel, sickness, restrictions, and adjusting operations. A proclamation to declare a local disaster emergency was also presented for presented. Young stated the Council could adopt the proclamation now or wait until a case was confirmed closer to the community.

Council member Jeff Albers moved to adopt a Proclamation of a State of Local Disaster Emergency for the City of Cheney, KS.

Council member Jeff Albers moved to adopted the proclamation for 180 days.
Council member Ryan Graf seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Council member Greg Kampling moved to adopt the COVID-19 Policy for employees and City operations with the discussed changes.
Council member Kassie Gile seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Council member Jeff Albers moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:17 pm.
